## DSC 2017 EUROPE VR

### DRIVING SIMULATION & VIRTUAL REALITY CONFERENCE & EXHIBITION

The DSC Conference gathers driving simulation specialists from the industrial and academic communities as well as commercial simulation providers. This 16<sup>th</sup> edition follows that of 2016, held in Paris, with approximately 220 participants and 22 exhibitors. Participants came from all around the world from about 20 different countries of Europe, America and Asia.

**This year's edition is planned to be held in Gothenburg (Sweden)** with an extended professional exhibition. Topics will include state of the art in driving simulation technology, research and developments, extended with progressively merging virtual reality (VR) developments. This year's program will also give an enlarged place for simulation tools for autonomous and connected vehicles along with advanced driving assistance system (ADAS) applications. Human factors and motion rendering nevertheless will remain the now traditional axis of the conference.

**The deadline for abstract submission is set to December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2016.** You are welcome to the DSC 2017 Europe Conference organized by the Driving Simulation Association, VTI, Arts et Métiers ParisTech, IFSTTAR and Renault with the sponsorship of Optis, held in Gothenburg, on September 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> on the Swedish west coast!
